Voluntary National Reviews

Voluntary National Reviews play a pivotal role in facilitating the exchange of experiences, including successes, challenges, and lessons learned, to accelerate the implementation of the 2030 Agenda. These reviews aim to strengthen government policies and institutions while mobilizing multi-stakeholder support and partnerships for SDG implementation.

Among the 44 selected countries, Uganda will feature in the ministerial segment of the forum and present her 3rd Voluntary National Review Report at the HLPF in July 2024...

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Quote: Assessing Uganda's progress on SDG 2, "Zero Hunger," involves examining factors such as food security, agricultural productivity, nutrition, and access to safe and nutritious food. Uganda faces challenges related to food insecurity, including fluctuations in agricultural production, limited access to inputs and markets, and vulnerability to climate change. Efforts to address these challenges include promoting sustainable agriculture, improving rural infrastructure, enhancing market access for smallholder farmers, and implementing nutrition programs. However, achieving zero hunger requires sustained commitment, investment, and collaboration across sectors to ensure food security and improved nutritional outcomes for all **Ugandans.**

- 1. Accelerating Leave No One Behind Agenda through the inclusive Parish Development Model Implementation
- Accelerate inclusive actions for Trade financing and Climate-Smart investments;
- Accelerate inclusive actions to leverage Science, Technology and Innovation;
- 4. Accelerating inclusive economic and social development through climate change adaptation and mitigation
- 5. Accelerate efforts to harness the full potential of data to improve the lives of all Ugandans
- 6. Accelerate strengthening SDG coordination and service delivery mechanisms.

Pathways for implementing commitments

- (i) Strong linkage of the commitments into the NDP IV
- (ii) Enhancing national and local financing
- iii) Strengthening partnerships for SDG localization and citizen participation, and
- (iv) Strengthening monitoring and reporting
