
Footprint Evaluation objective: embed consideration of environmental sustainability in all evaluations and monitoring systems

- Include standard questions on environmental sustainability in evaluations of agricultural / rural development programs
 - include socioeconomic sustain. in environmental evaluations
- Conceptualize the nexus between rural dev. and environment
- Important: **polyfunctionality** of rural dev / environmental interventions



Conceptualizing co-benefits in GEF-funded interventions


Co-benefits in a GEF-funded intervention: a conceptual scheme



Co-benefits, supported by any complementary investments, and institutional / policy changes help scale up effects and improve sustainability chances
